The car must be booked in advance by e-mailing [ian Devonshire](mailto:ian@devonshire.com). This is required so a date can be agreed, as the car may not be available due to other bookings. You will be able to take part in a full race meeting, competing against other relative novices.

First time use of the car will be **completely free**. For any subsequent bookings a charge of £10 per meeting will be made to cover the race fee and wear and tear of the car. We do hold a reasonable supply of spares for the car but if it breaks and we are unable to get it working then no alternative is available.

The intent is for people to have a go before they buy their own, not to use it instead of buying your own.
